"Beyond the Spill" Panel Discussion



PRS hosted an Expert Panel Discussion on the 19th of June, 2025, titled "Beyond the Spill: Unpacking the Kafue River Disaster", bringing together leading experts to examine the environmental, legal, health, and food safety implications of the recent heavy metal spill in River. The discussion Zambia's Kafue underscored the urgent need for enhanced environmental monitoring, public integration, and legal enforcement.

Key Takeaways:

- Metals like lead, cadmium, and arsenic persist in the environment, accumulating in soil, water, and plant life — with long-term consequences for ecosystems and public health.
- Zambia's health system is not adequately prepared to detect or respond to chemical-related emergencies like heavy metal poisoning.
- The approx. ZMW 32,000 offered to each 'affected farmer' is grossly insufficient, given the long-term soil and water contamination from heavy metals.
